As a junior member of West Bridgfordians Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following junior Club Rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Remember to say please and thank you when asking for a guard when batting.
- All members must respect own team mates and opposition players.
- Don't "sledge"
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear appropriate kit for training sessions (cricket trousers or training bottoms, club cricket shirt or T-shirt, boots or training shoes)
- If representing the club players are encouraged to wear white WBCC shirts and trousers, otherwise definitely white shirt and trousers. In colder weather white sweaters / cricket jumpers are permitted, but NO hoodies. Ideally all boys and girls playing hardball cricket should be wearing spiked shoes, however many junior matches are played on artificial pitches so ensure you check with your team manager what footwear to bring to matches.
- When playing in any match, whether it's a friendly, interclub, league or cup match, ALWAYS tuck your shirt in.
- Members must pay any fees for training, matches or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the Club.
- Talk to an adult at the club if you have any problems. We are happy to listen.
